

SIERRA SPRINGS RECREATIONAL FACILITIES RULES & CALIFORNIA LAWS

Pool Rules:

Sierra Springs Recreational Facilities are for the enjoyment of members and their guests and no inappropriate behavior will be tolerated.

NO: running on deck, profanity, pushing, throwing people in the pool, horseplay, or unsafe action in or around pool.

NO: rafts, hard balls, or loud music

NO: diving in shallow end. No removal or playing with life saving equipment

NO: diapers, cutoffs, etc. Regulation swimsuits only. Nothing inappropriate for a family recreation facility. (approved pool diapers are available at the lodge for babies/toddlers)

NO: glass, weapons, scuba equipment

NO: climbing on solar panels or handrails

NO: Bicycles, skates, scooters, skateboards, etc.

NO: pets allowed within the keyed areas

NO: loitering in parking lot before, during, or after swimming hours.

***Members are only allowed 6 guests**, plus family in household. Pool facilities are only for the enjoyment of members, their families and guests and may not be rented or loaned out.

*An adult must accompany children under 14.

*You must be at least 14 years to swim without a parent.

*14 to 17 year olds are not permitted to bring a guest. (Member's children 18 years or older are permitted to bring 1 guest.) Be prepared to show ID.

*Violators will be asked to leave and may face a loss of pool privileges.

*You may be asked for ID when using the recreational facilities.

*The Sierra Springs Staff will adjust pool hours according to water conditions and weather.

Lodge Rules:

NO ONE UNDER 18 IS ALLOWED IN THE LODGE UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY AN ADULT.

Turn off all lights, heater. Lock all doors and windows when leaving. No one under 14 allowed to use the pool tables.

Playground: An adult must supervise children under 14

OFF-ROAD VEHICLES: are not allowed on any Sierra Springs roads or in any recreational areas.
